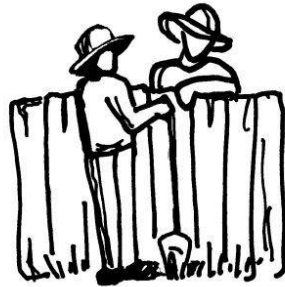

Four Easy Steps

1) Gather contact information from the college students on your block and copy it onto the provided contact list...

- This information should include the name, phone number, and address from at least one student at each house.
- Explain the Better Neighbors program to the college students. Let them know that this is a way to provide the opportunity for open communication between neighbors, and ask if they are willing to participate.
- If they are, record their information on the contact sheet provided.

2) Bring the contact sheet into the Student Association Office (KSC 115) and ask a member to help you make copies to distribute to the local residents on your block.

- If a member is not available leave the contact list on the Better Neighbor's desk with your email and the number of copies you need written on the back. You will be emailed when your copies are ready to be picked up.

3) While in the Student Association Office leave your Neighborhood Representative Form (page 3) in the Completed Application folder at the Better Neighbor's Desk.

4) Distribute a copy of the contact information you collect to each resident house on your block.

- If no one is home, you can leave a copy outside their door.
